We also learnt new sounds like m and we write this using Maisie, Mountain, Mountain. As well as this we were blending words together and deciding if they were nonsense or not.

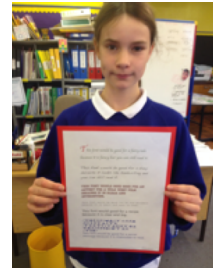
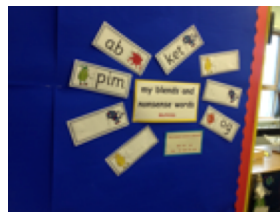
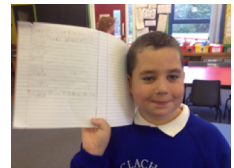
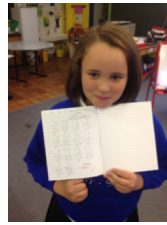
Some other children were learning to spell their key words correctly in their work.
